Breathtaking scenery, thrilling adventures and world-class food and wine. It's all just around the next corner on your Great Ocean Road trip.

SURF COASTING **A**

Torquay - Anglesea - Lorne - Apollo Bay
Driving Distance: 92km
 Start your Great Ocean Road experience at the surf capital - Torquay home of Belis Beach and many surf spots along the way. Check out the kangaroos at Anglesea, coastal lookouts, lunch and don't forget to take a coffee break between 'the breaks'.

OTWAY HARVEST TRAIL **D**

Lorne - Deans Marsh - Birregurra - Gellibrand - Beech Forrest - Forrest
Driving Distance: 163km
 Allow a full day or more to explore. Winding through the Otways region, enjoy many culinary experiences including berry picking, fresh produce, wineries and breweries, provender and farm gates. Visit: otwayharvesttrail.org.au for opening times and an update of seasonal produce.

WALKS AND WATERFALLS **C**

Apollo Bay - Cape Otway - Lavers Hill - Beech Forrest - Apollo Bay
Driving Distance: 125km
 This stunning loop drive includes highlights such as the Cape Otway Lightstation, Great Otway National Park, Otway Fly Treetop Adventures, Triplet Falls, waterfalls, rainforest walks and galleries.

12 APOSTLES GOURMET TRAIL **F**

Port Campbell - Cooriemungle - Camperdown - Timboon - Port Campbell
Driving Distance: 115km
 Take your tastebuds on a journey that will leave you craving for more. Join the 115km 12 Apostles Gourmet foods and wine trail (previously named the food, wine and vista loop). Sample award-winning cheeses, wine, chocolate, berries, ice-cream and whisky (for the non-driver).

HISTORIC SHIPWRECK TRAIL **B**

Lavers Hill - Princetown - Port Campbell - Warrnambool
Driving Distance: 113km
 The highlight of a Great Ocean Road experience including the 12 Apostles and Loch Ard Gorge during which you can view some of the sites where gales, human error and, in some cases, foul play caused many ships to be wrecked.

SURF COAST & MOORABOOL WINES **E**

Winchelsea - Bannockburn - Ceres - Bellbrae - Winchelsea
Driving Distance: 121km
 The rolling hills and valleys of the Moorabool Valley around Winchelsea, Inverleigh and Bellbrae areas have a warm, continental style climate, while vineyards closer to the coastal breezes produce excellent cool climate shiraz. Collect a Geelong and Moorabool Valley Wine map from a Visitor Centre.

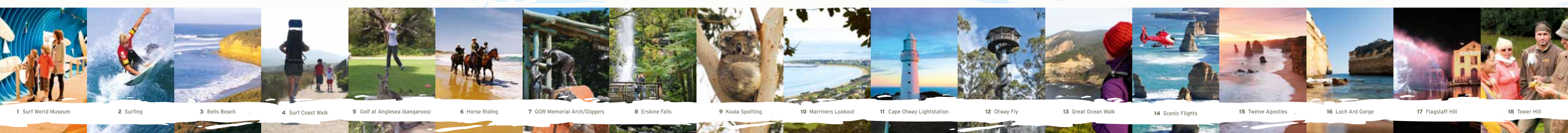
